## Administrator of the Year Award

# Eligibility:

To recognize a Florida library administrator who has made significant contributions through distinguished service to their library or librarianship. This award is intended for people employed in leadership positions such as branch managers, assistant/deputy/associate directors, library administrators, and directors.

## Nominee must:

 Be an employed library administrator in a Florida academic, public, school or special library.

This award shall be bestowed on a nominee based on either accomplishment during the current year or during several years of activity.

The nominator must be a current member of the Florida Library Association.

## Criteria:

Eligible nominees should meet some, but not necessarily all, of the following criteria:

- Active leadership in professional associations or on professional committees.
- Support of statewide advocacy efforts.
- Commitment to free access to information for all.
- Commitment to the community through partnership efforts.
- Achieved strategic plan goals and vision with measurable positive outcomes.
- Outstanding work on a particular aspect of library service.
